- The Eighteenth Century is called the Classical Age in English literature on account of three reasons.
 1. In the first place, the term 'classic', refers in general, applies to writers of the highest rank in any nation. This term was first applied to the works of the great Greek and Roman writers, like Homer and Virgil.
- As the writers of the eighteenth century in England tried to follow the simple and noble methods of the great ancient writers, they began to be called Classical writers.

The 18th century saw the development of the modern novel as literary genre, in fact many candidates for the first novel in English date from this period, of which Daniel Defoe's *Robinson Crusoe* is probably the best known.
