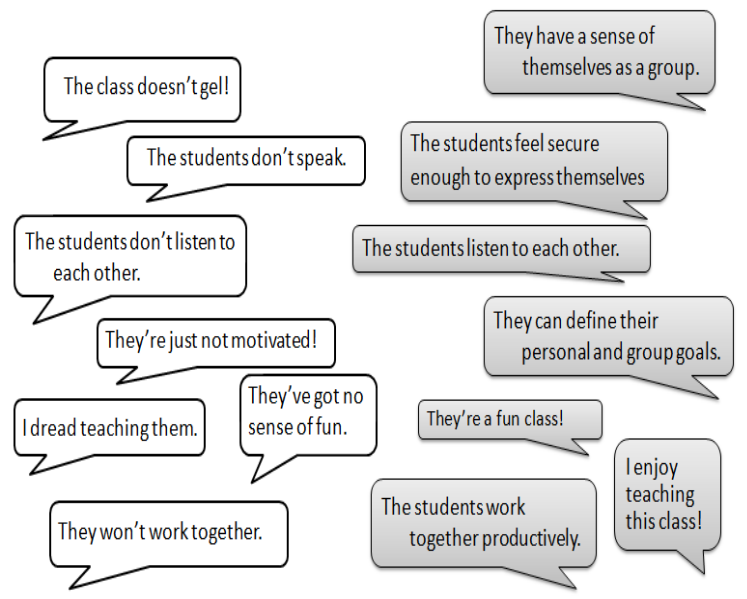


Classroom Dynamics
